

POLICY STATEMENT NO. 2

The Phoenix Branch Younger Member Forum (PBYMF) Board Members held the first Officer Retreat on Saturday, December 7, 2002. The purpose of this event was to give the new officers a chance to get to know each other, give an overview of AzSCE and the PBYMF, review past activities, discuss current and future activities, and to create a calendar for the year's meetings and activities.

Based on the success and benefits of the 2002 Officer Retreat, the PBYMF Board Members would like to make the Officer Retreat an annual event.
